Coronavirus. The new prevention measures updated to the Prime Ministerial Decree of 11 March 2020, to the Prime Ministerial Decree of 22 March 2020 and regional ordinance.

OBJECTIVE: TO AVOID GATHERINGS AND TO LIMIT AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE MOVEMENT OF PEOPLE THAT ARE NOT NECESSARY FOR REASONS FOR WORK, HEALTH AND NEEDS (e.g., GROCERY SHOPPING).

The measurements are valid until 03 April 2020, unless otherwise indicated.

COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES (NEIGHBORHOOD EXERCISES)

In the following FERIAL AND PREFESTIVE DAYS, only the following activities for the <u>sale of food and basic</u> <u>necessities are ALLOWED in the neighbourhood shops</u>, provided that access is granted to such activities only and always ensuring the interpersonal safety distance of one metre:

Minimarkets and other non-specialized food shops

Retail sale of frozen products

Non-specialized retail trade in computers, peripherals, telecommunications equipment, audio and video consumer electronics, household appliances

Retail sale of food, beverages and tobacco in specialized stores (ateco codes: 47.2)

Retail sale of automotive fuel in specialised shops

Retail sale of computer and telecommunication equipment (ICT) in specialist shops (ateco code: 47.4)

Retail sale of hardware, paints, flat glass and electrical and thermohydraulic equipment

Retail sale of sanitary ware

Retail sale of lighting equipment

Retail sale of newspapers, magazines and periodicals

Pharmacies

Herbalists

Retail sale of non-prescription medicinal products in other specialist shops

Retail sale of medical and orthopaedic articles in specialist shops

Retail sale of perfumery, toilet and personal hygiene products

Trade carried out by means of vending machines

The newsstands, tobacconists, pharmacies and par pharmacies are still open (ensuring a distance of one metre of personal safety). In the case of activities of bars with tobacco shop, the activity of administration should be suspended and only the tobacco shop activity kept open. Retail of electronic cigarettes and liquid inhalation products may also remain open. The sale is permitted both in ordinary tobacco shops and in nearby shops other than tobacco shops, provided that they are specialised in the exclusive sale of electronic cigarettes and liquid inhalation products.

COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES (MEDIUM AND LARGE SALES FACILITIES AND SHOPS PRESENT IN THE MALLS)

In the FERIAL DAYS, both in the medium and large distribution, including the shopping centres, are ALLOWED the only activities of sale of food and basic necessities listed below, provided that access is granted to such activities only and always ensuring the interpersonal safety distance of one metre:

Supermarkets

Discount of food products

Minimarkets and other non-specialised grocery stores

Retail sale of frozen products

Retail sale in non-specialised stores of computers, peripherals, telecommunications equipment, audio and video consumer electronics, household appliances

Retail sale of food, beverages and tobacco in specialised stores (ateco code: 47.2)

Retail sale of computer and telecommunication equipment (ICT) in specialist shops (ateco code: 47.4)

Retail sale of hardware, paints, flat glass and electrical and thermohydraulic equipment

Retail sale of sanitary ware

Retail sale of lighting equipment

Retail sale of newspapers, magazines and periodicals

Pharmacies

Retail sale of non-prescription medicinal products in other specialist shops

Medium and large sales structures are closed on PREFESTIVE DAYS, as well as the shops inside the shopping centres, with the exception of pharmacies, parapharmacies and food outlets, provided that access is allowed only to the aforementioned activities. Therefore, supermarkets in shopping malls can open on holidays and pre-holidays only for the sales areas of pharmaceutical, parapharmaceutical and food products. Any form of assembly is prohibited.

On HOLIDAY DAYS, with the exception of newsstands, pharmacies and parapharmacies, all retail and wholesale activities are suspended, including the sale of food products, both in the neighbourhood and medium and large structures sales, even included in shopping centres or in shopping galleries.

ALL OTHER RETAIL BUSINESSES ARE SUSPENDED!

Markets

All the ordinary and extraordinary markets, the markets with exclusive merchandise, the markets and the fairs are SUSPENDED, including the markets with exclusive merchandise for the sale of food products and, more generally, the parking places destined and used for the sale of food products.

ACTIVITY OF ADMINISTRATION

Catering activities are suspended (including bars, pubs, restaurants, ice cream parlours, pastry shops). To integration and as an example in the list above of the suspended activities are to be included also pizzerias to the cut, kebabs, fryers, etc.

IT REMAINS ALLOWED:

- -the only catering with home delivery in compliance with the hygienic and sanitary rules both for the activity of packaging and transport
- continuous canteen and catering activities on a contractual basis which ensure the interpersonal safety distance of one metre.
- the activity of food and drink
- along the motorways, which may sell only take-away products to be consumed outside the premises;
- in hospitals and airports, with an obligation to ensure in any case respect for the interpersonal distance of at least one metre

The food and beverage supply establishments inside railway and lake stations, as well as in the service and fuel supply areas, are CLOSED, except as mentioned above;

ARTISAN ACTIVITIES TO PEREONAL SERVICES

Activities relating to personal services (including hairdressers, barbers, beauticians) are suspended. MAY REMAIN OPEN ONLY: laundry and cleaning of textiles and fur, industrial laundries, other laundries, dry cleaners, funeral homes and related activities.

BANKING, FINANCIAL, INSURANCE AND AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES

The banking, financial and insurance services, as well as the activities of the agricultural, livestock and food processing sector, including the supply chains providing goods and services, are still guaranteed, subject to health and hygiene standards.

PRODUCTIVE ACTIVITIES AND PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

Without prejudice to the provisions of DPCM 11.03.2020 for commercial activities, all industrial and commercial production activities are SUSPENDED, with the exception of those listed in Annex 1 below, WHICH ARE ALLOWED, and subject to the following provisions.

The productive activities that would be suspended can however continue if organized in modality to distance or agile job.

They are however allowed

- activities providing public utilities, as well as essential services referred to in Law No. 146 of 12 June 1990.
- the activities which are designed to ensure the continuity of the activities listed in Annex 1 and of the utilities and essential services referred to in the preceding paragraph, prior notification to the Prefect of the province where the production activity is located.
- the activity of production, transport, marketing and delivery of medicines, health technology and medical-surgical devices as well as agricultural and food products. Any activity, however functional, to deal with the emergency is also allowed.
- the activities of plants with a continuous production cycle, after informing the Prefect of the province where the production activity is located, from whose interruption there is a serious injury to the plant itself or a risk of accidents.
- the activities of the aerospace and defence industries, as well as other activities of strategic importance for the national economy, subject to authorisation by the Prefect of the province where the production activities are located.

Professional activities are ALLOWED, subject to the following provisions.

With regard to production activities and professional activities, it is recommended that:

- 1. maximum use is made by undertakings of agile working methods for activities that can be carried out at home or in distance mode;
- 2. there should be incentives for holidays and paid leave for employees and other collective bargaining instruments;
- 3. the activities of the company departments not indispensable to production are suspended;
- 4. assume safety protocols and, where it is not possible to respect the interpersonal distance of one metre as the main containment measure, adopt personal protection instruments;
- 5. incentives should be provided for the rehabilitation of workplaces, including the use of forms of social shock absorbers for this purpose;
- 6. for production activities only, it is also recommended to limit as far as possible movements within the sites and limit access to common areas;

With reference to the examples given on the institutional sites of the Government, provided that contact with clients is limited and the necessary health precautions are taken (respect of the interpersonal safety distance of at least one metre, use of protective gloves and health masks) and promote, where possible, the activity of sale by mail and internet of spare parts and accessories, ARE ALLOWED:

- repair and maintenance of motor vehicles and motorcycles (mechanical workshops, body shops, repair and replacement of tyres)
- related activities to enable the performance of maintenance and repair activities such as the wholesale and retail sale of spare parts and accessories

ACCOMODATION STRUCTURES

The accommodation facilities (hotels, residences, farmhouses, tourist villages, campsites, hostels and Bed & Breakfast) can remain OPEN and inside they are allowed the catering services only for the customers who stay there.

GAMES / BETTING GAMES

It is foreseen for the continuation of the state of emergency and until the order of revocation:

- a. suspension with immediate effect of the game operated with electronic devices of the type "slot machines", however called, located within the resale shops;
- b. the suspension of the collection of the games described below at the "tobacco shops" and other establishments for which there is no obligation to close them, with the following dates:
- «SuperEnalotto», «Superstar», «sivincetutto» «SuperEnalotto», «Lotto tradizionale»: from the end of the competitions on Saturday 21 March 2020; the suspension for such games is extended to the online collection modality as well as to the consequent extranational activities in order to further limit the movements and the contact of the subjects whose presence would be necessary for the proper development of the aforementioned activities;
- «eurojackpot» the suspension for this game is extended to the online collection mode and has immediate effect:
- c. bets involving certification by Agency staff: from 22 March 2020.
